

Hansen SeaPass Passenger Suit



SOLAS Approved. Emergency thermal protection suit for passenger vessels. Compatible with survival kit according to LSA Polar Code.

SeaPass is a lightweight, uninsulated immersion suit compliant with IMO SOLAS standards, providing 1 hour of thermal protection in water temperatures below 5°C. It's perfect for use on passenger vessels or as extra safety gear for leisure crafts. This suit should be worn alongside a certified lifejacket. SeaPass can be vacuum-packed for easy storage, taking up minimal space on board. When vacuum-packed by Hansen Protection, it has a recommended service interval of 10 years. Additionally, users can wear their own shoes either inside or outside the suit.

Key Features:

- Emergency suit on board passenger vessels and recreational vessels

- PU coated Nylon
- Requires use of additional approved lifejacket
- Integrated insulated hood in neoprene
- Front zipper with waterproof gusset underneath
- Attached 5-finger gloves
- Adjustable ankle straps

- Approved in accordance with SOLAS' LSA Code MED/1.5a as an uninsulated immersion suit, designed to be used with lifejacket.

- The suit with compatible lifejacket is approved as substitute to thermal lifejackets according to Norwegian Maritime Directorate's (NMD's) regulations
- Tested to NMD's requirements in "Guidelines for passenger suits for Norwegian passenger vessels"
- Vacuum packing for extended service interval to 10 years
- 1 hour thermal protection
- Extremely light weight and easy to store
